FINAL ENTRY INFORMATION

Please complete a Final Entry Registration Card for each exhibitor using the link on the website. You must complete 1 entry per child. To participate in the show, you must be 8 years old by the current 4H year (Oct 1, 2021). Entry fees must be included with the Final Entry Tally form to be entered into the show. Any cards that are received without the corresponding entry fee will not be entered into the show. Entries will only be accepted by club/chapter, <u>DO NOT</u> send individual entry fees. Please complete entry cards and final tally forms as soon as possible. DEADLINE FOR ENTRY IS APRIL 4 AT 11:59 PM. ENTRY FEES MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN THIS DATE TO BE ACCEPTED. THIS RULE WILL BE FOLLOWED, NO EXCEPTIONS.

Space is available on the grounds for campers, trailers, and trucks. A \$50 fee will be charged for each living unit. Camping money will be collected as you enter the grounds on Thursday, April 28. **DO NOT SEND**CAMPING MONEY WITH FINAL ENTRY. Spaces are on a first come first serve basis. No entry until Thursday April 28th at 8 AM. Electricity will be turned on Saturday, April 30th and turned off on Wednesday evening May 4th. Not all campsites have electricity. CAMPING IS FOR EXHIBITORS AND PERSONS APPROVED BY LEADERS/ ADVISORS ONLY. THERE MUST BE AN ADULT IN EACH SITE.

Three animals of the same species (beef not included) may be weighed and all need paperwork. Exhibitors must choose 2 before they are off the truck to be tagged. If the animal to be tagged does not make weight, they may bring the other off the truck to be weighed in its place. Each exhibitor will only be allowed 2 entries into the show. Market Health Records are due at scales on Sunday, one per animal; **do not send with final entry**. Market health records can be **downloaded from our website**. If you do not have your paperwork at weigh in your animals will not be weighed. Additional papers will not be handed out in line, make sure you have yours when you arrive.

Lambs: Any lamb prolapsed before the show may not enter and any lamb that prolepses during the show will be removed from show and sent home.

ABSOLUTELY NO ANTIBIOTIC RESIDUE CAN BE FOUND IN ANY ANIMAL CARCASS, THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT. Exhibitors will not be paid for any rejected carcass. The show reserves the right to random drug test any animal entered in the show at any time.

There will be an exhibitor meeting at the sales arena at 5:00 PM, Sunday, May 1st. This meeting is required for all exhibitors. After the meeting, we will be having an adult fitting and showing contest. This will include parents, leaders/advisors, and volunteers involved in the show. A signup sheet and entry fee will be collected in the office on Sunday.

All decorations and Herdsmanship signs are to be left up as display until the last animal in your species sells.

If you notice any animals at the show that are not being properly taken care of with food and water, please notify the superintendent of that species immediately. All animals are to be fed and watered through Wednesday morning. Premium points will be taken from all exhibitors in clubs/chapters if animals are not taken care of properly the entire time they are at the show.

Each club/chapter will be responsible to bring one poster to be displayed by the show turned in by 3:00 on Sunday. Size should be approx. 18" X 22" and express thanks from your club/chapter to volunteers, BBQ, breakfast sponsors, etc. which can be found in the premium book.
